Match Waiver Process

- A process to waive, either partly or fully, a grantee's match requirement
- A Microsoft Forms document needs to be completed, where the person completing it will self-certify information on why the match waiver is needed
- There is no formal documentation required for each response, but each criteria must be met



Match Waiver Process (2)

- The Microsoft Forms link can be found on Serve KY's website
 - Complete the form, Serve KY will then review it and provide any feedback
 - Once Serve KY staff feel the form is ready, Serve KY staff will send it to AmeriCorps on the program's behalf
- The Match Waiver can be completed at any point during a grant's 3-year cycle, and at any time during a performance period
 - The program can apply for one year, two years, or three years but no more years than is left in the program's 3-year cycle



Match Waiver Process (3)

- Per 45 CFR 2521.70, all four criteria must be described and met:
 - Lack of resources at the local level
 - Lack of resources in the local community is unique or unusual
 - Efforts you have made to raise matching resources
 - Amount of matching resources you have raised, or reasonably expect to raise



Alternative Match Request

- Allows applicants that are under certain circumstances the ability to meet a match schedule with a lower percentage than typically required
 - Maximum match requirement is 35% instead of 50%

Alternative Match Request (2)

- Requirements to request an Alternative Match:
 - Must be in a rural county (based on Beale codes), or, a severely economically distressed county
 - The Legal Applicant address must be used, unless approved otherwise by AmeriCorps
 - This must be submitted as part of the Request for Application (RFA) process
 - If approved, the Alternative Match is for the full three-year cycle (or what is remaining)



Comparison Chart

| Match Waiver Process | Alternative Match Request |
|---------------------------------|---|
| MS Forms Document | Part of the RFA process |
| Waive match, in-full or in-part | Reduce the match % |
| Based on 45CFR 2421.70 | Based on Beale Codes & County-Level Economic Data |
| Program can be located anywhere | Legal entity must be in a rural county or a severely economically distressed county |
| Self-certified information | Beale Codes & County-Level Economic Data must be met |
| Due at any point | Due in conjunction with application submission |
